## Dear Residents:

As we continue to monitor developments regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19), we want to assure you we are staying on top of this evolving situation.

Efforts to disinfect frequently touched surfaces in common areas multiple times a day are in place, but we ask your cooperation in following all preventative measures when accessing these areas of the community.

The World Health Organization (WHO) and the Centers of Disease Control (CDC) recommend the following basic preventative measures:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds. If soap and water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Frequently clean and disinfect "high-touch" surfaces.
- Cover your cough and sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue away.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Put distance between yourself and other people.
- Stay at home when you are sick and contact your healthcare provider. Avoid public areas and limit contact with others.
